Subject	Theme	Content
English	Character descriptions  Letters  Balanced Arguments	Our book this term is 'The Boy in the Girls Bathroom' by Louis Sachar. We will use this as a stimulus for our writing. The book is based upon friendship and acceptance told through the eyes of a young boy at school.
Maths	Fractions 2	We will continue to learn about fractions, this term looking at adding and subtracting fractions from one another.
Science	Living things and their habitats	We will be looking at the life processes of plants and comparing the differences between life cycles of mammals, amphibians, reptiles, birds and fish. We will also learn about Jane Goodhall and David Attenborough
History	The Roman Empire	Children will be investigating the key questions: When and why did the Romans invade Britain? How and why did Britain fight back against the romans? Hadrian's wall and its significance to Rome.
Geography	Coastal Processes	We will be studying coastal habitats and the process of transporting and deposition. We will be looking at the Jurassic Coast as a case study.
RER RE	The life of Jesus	We will continue to learn about the life of Jesus focusing on the sermon on the mount, parables, miracles and the transfiguration of Jesus.
