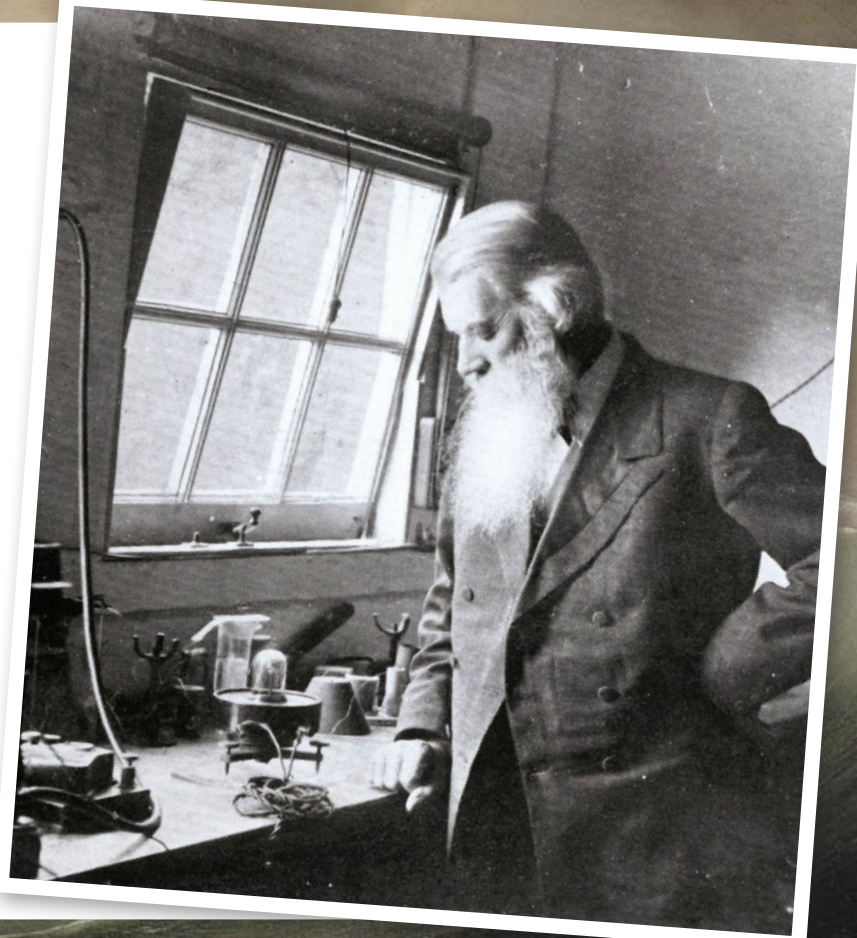
The Victorian era saw an explosion of inventions and innovations. Advances in industry, new scientific discoveries, an urge to succeed and shared expertise helped start a revolution.

Here are some key inventions from the Victorian era.

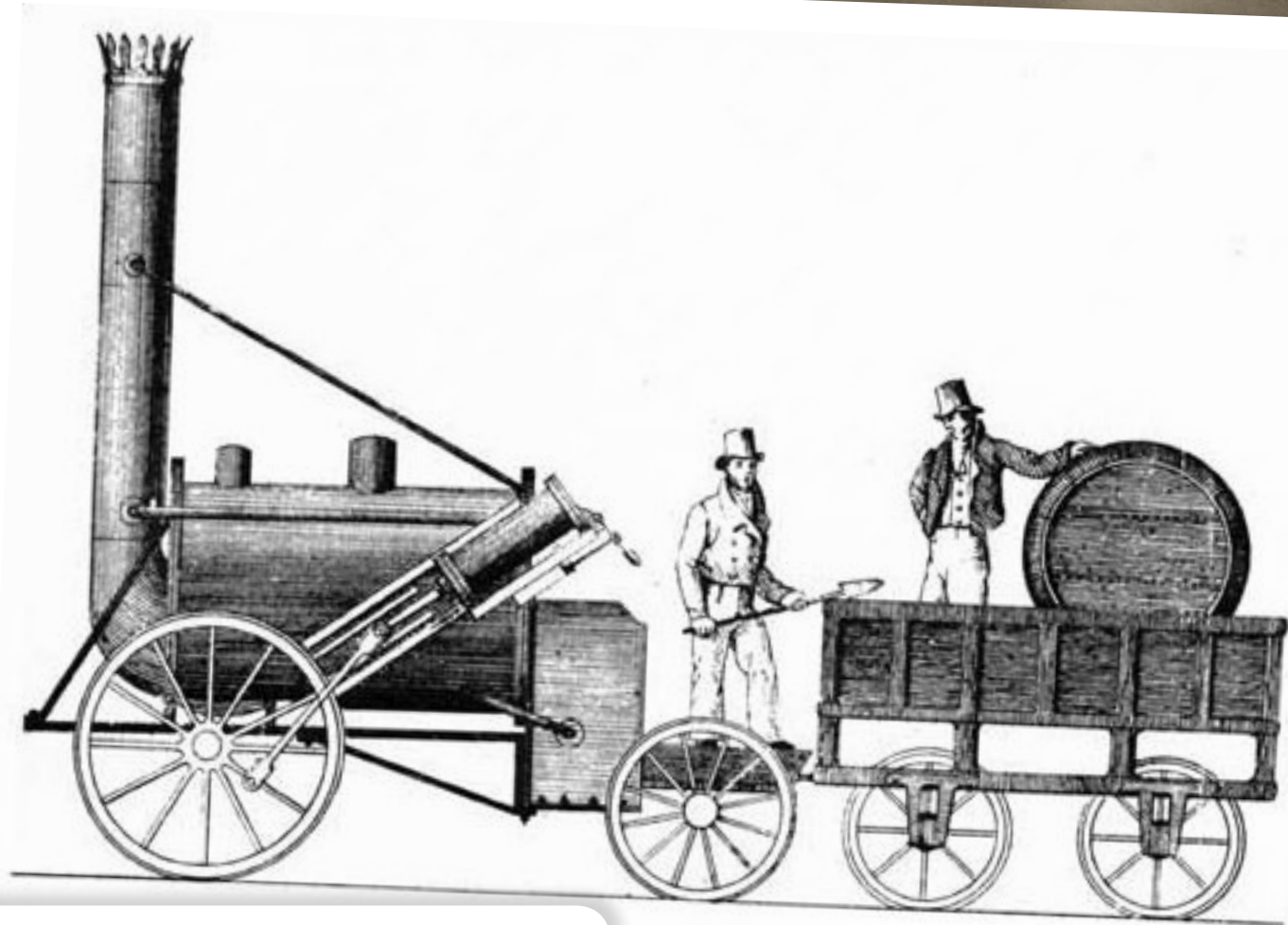

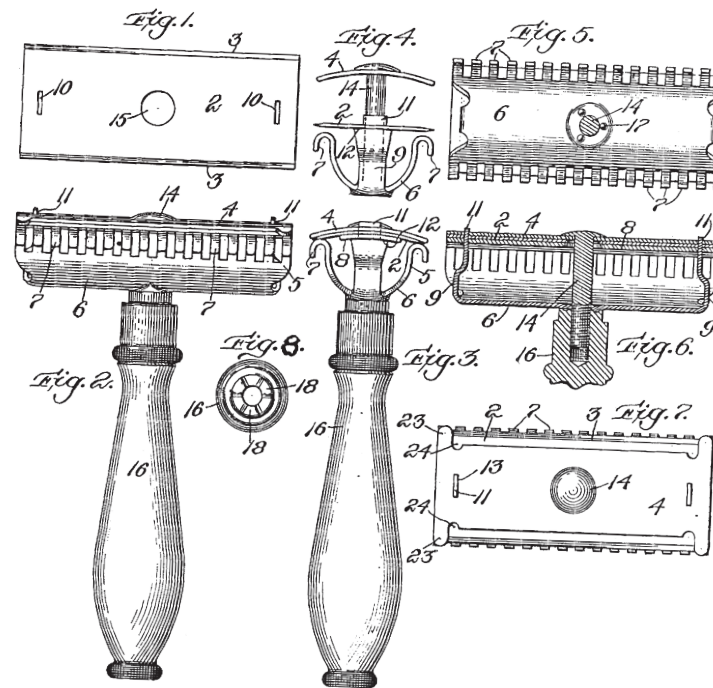

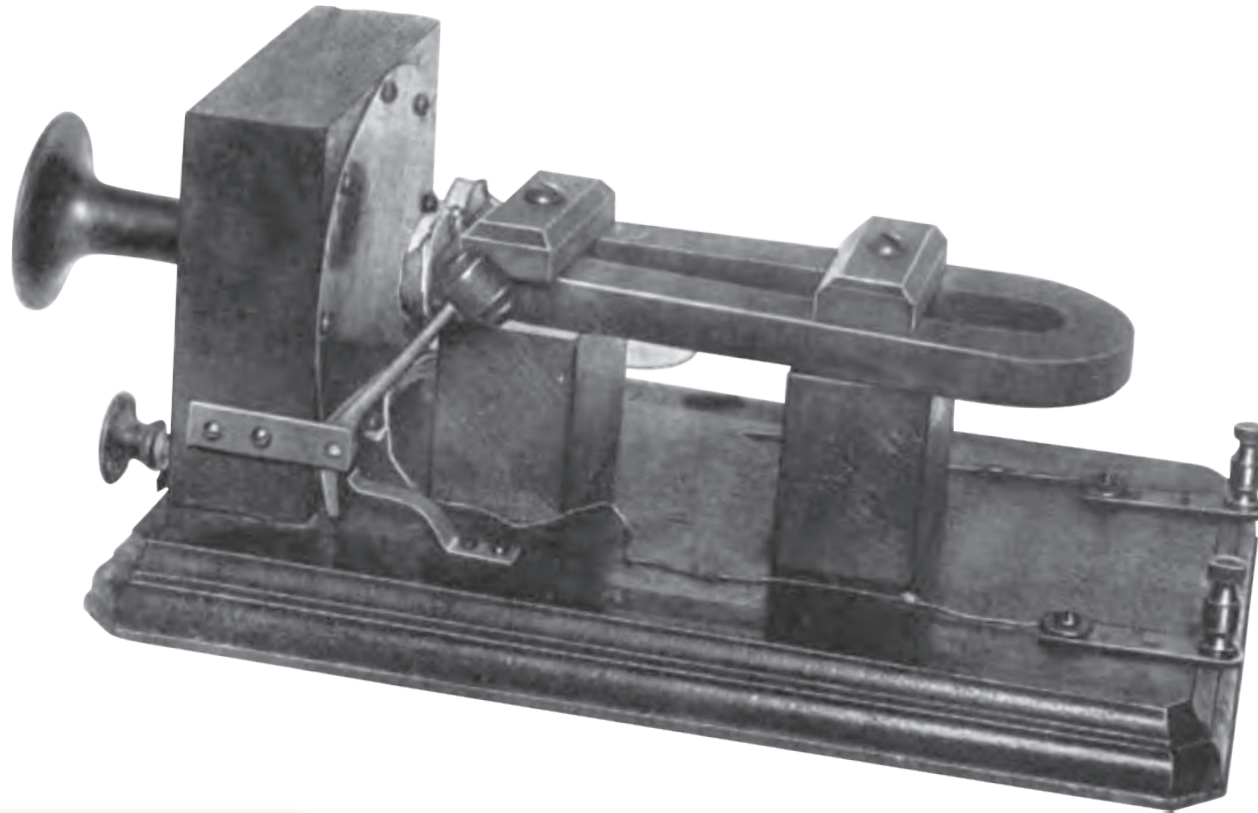
