


We have been taking a look back at all the books that we have read and worked on this year. We had a lot of fun remembering the books and all the exciting activities that we did!

Year 5 children played their Cellos to years 3 and 4. They played beautifully and showed how much you can progress with an extra year of playing. Well done!



Recycling Projects here at Chestnuts




Thank you to all the parents, carers and children who have brought in their empty crisp packets for recycling. As you can see in a short space of time we have managed to pack up three large boxes!

We also recycle empty tooth paste tubes, brushes and all things related to teeth.


All recycling places are in the school reception.
